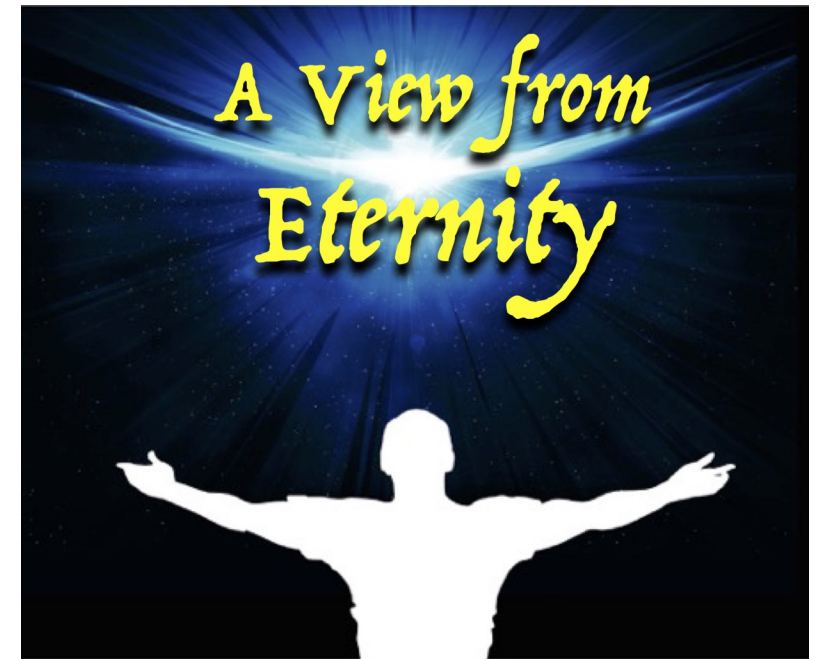
## MISSION STATEMENT OF THE PANAMA UMC
