PRIMARY GOALS OF THE PANAMA UMC

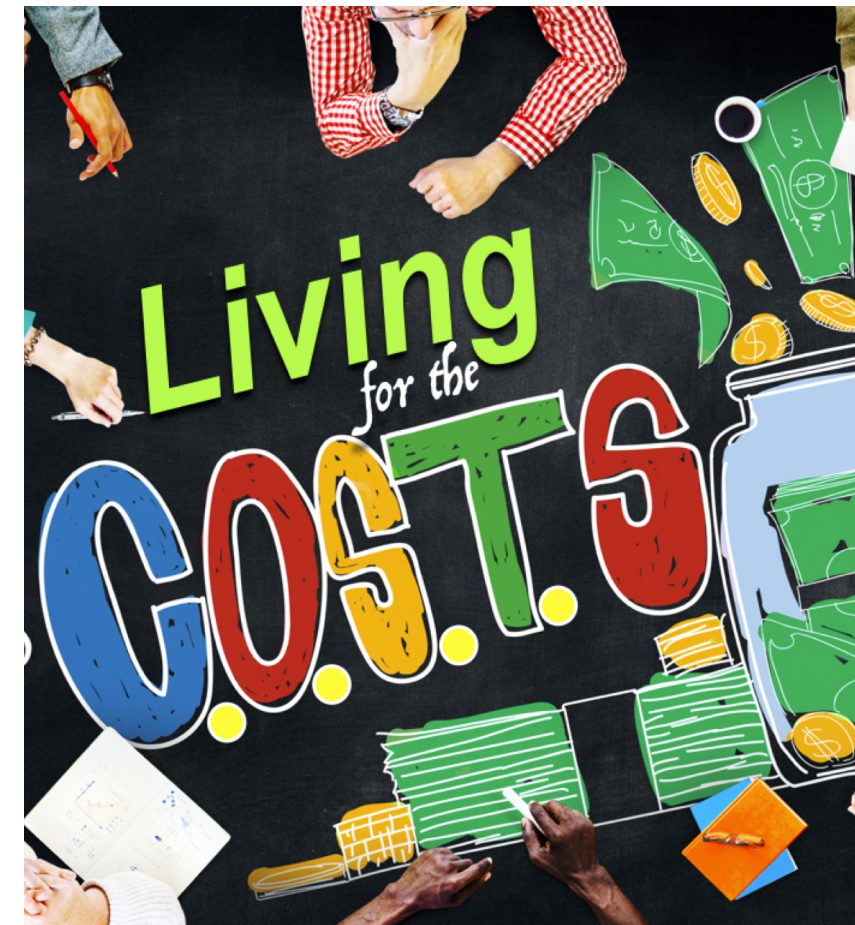
1. Helping people turn away from a life of self-rule and becoming fully-devoted followers of Jesus Christ.

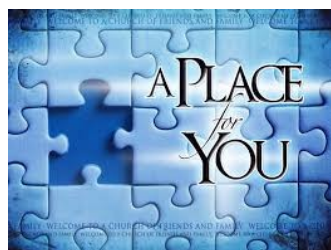
