PRIMARY GOALS of the Panama UMC

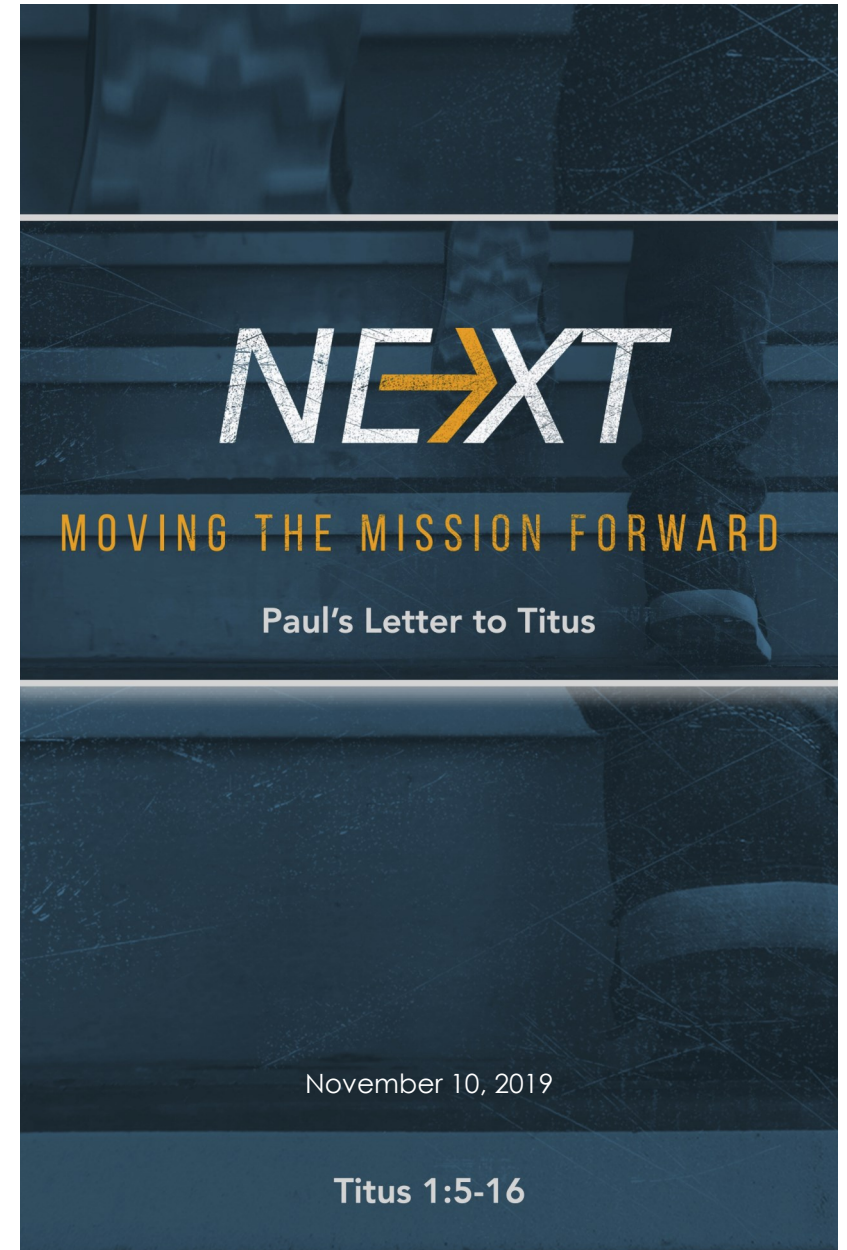

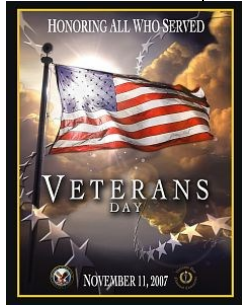
