From Pastor Steve's Desk...

(This is the next installment of an ongoing series of articles regarding what we believe, why we believe it, and why it matters. In the United Methodist Church, there is change coming. Within our global denomination, we have some serious divergent views on the authority of scripture, human sexuality, and what that means in the world and in our church. We aren't sure what the changes will look like, but we know that in order to respond to God's call to be the church in the 21st century, the anchor of our doctrinal identity, we need to know what that is. So, I invite you to join me on this journey for God's glory and to build up the church.)

...on doctrine...

Part 16 - Of Baptism

One of my favorite duties as the pastor of the church is the baptism of people in the congregation who are growing in spiritual maturity. When someone asks me to baptize them, adult or youth, or to baptize a child, I am honored and humbled. Yet, I also pray that the single motivation for the person coming to me to be baptized is the Holy Spirit's prompting them to accept God's gift of grace and make a public profession of faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. For children, the parent(s) are the ones who make that initial commitment for them.

Baptism is, therefore, a joy and a challenge. It's a joy for both the person being baptized and the congregation because it's a celebration of how God is working in their lives. It's a challenge for both the congregation and the person being baptized because it's the beginning of a journey that is not always easy, but through which we are all continually renewed and strengthened as Christian disciples. Baptism is not simply fire insurance, saving a child of adult from hell. It is, however, a gift from God that envelopes a human being into the kingdom of God, as a response to their acceptance of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior,

As a church, a clear and concise understanding of baptism is critical to our understanding of who God is calling us to be and how God interacts with us through the Holy Spirit. Here's what Article of Religion 18 says about this: "Baptism is not only a sign of profession and mark of difference whereby Christians are distinguished from others that are not baptized; but it is also a sign of regeneration of the new birth. The Baptism of young children is to be retained in the Church." (From The Book of Discipline of The United Methodist Church - 2004. Copyright - 2016 by The United Methodist Publishing House.)

Baptism, therefore, is both a ritual that sets Christians apart from those who are not baptized, and it is an outward sign of new birth into a life that is committed to the teachings of Jesus Christ. One cannot be fully Christian without being baptized - it is our sign and seal of identity in Christ. In addition, one cannot fully live into one's baptism vows without accepting God's gift of regeneration from sin through Jesus.

OK, that's great for adults, but, you may ask, why do we baptize children? The short answer is: because that's what we do. Yet, theologically and biblically, those who are not yet old enough to accept God's grace for themselves are brought into the kingdom of God by persons representing the support structure for that child. In due time, given the nurture that child receives from both the parents/guardians AND the congregation, that child will fully live into the covenant made with God at baptism. This happens when they accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior for themselves (in the UMC, this usually happens around confirmation age), completing the sign of new birth.

Speaking of confirmation, we will soon be starting a confirmation class, which includes an invitation for baptism. As we celebrate with joy the public professions of faith, let us also be bound together to accept the challenge of continuing to nurture all these persons as we grow in faith and spiritual maturity.

God is pouring out great blessings on our church. I thank God for our willingness to give Him the glory and honor and praise for it all.

This weekend, we are celebrating Labor day, a day set aside to relax from our labors. Here at PUMC, we are participating in a Labor of Love, giving to the CenterPoint campaign. As Kyle reported last month, we have already paid \$79,000 of the principal. With this month's receipts, we will pay an additional \$8,000 of the principal. This month we have received \$16,468.67 for a total of \$740,969.09, which is 79 percent of the goal of \$932,793.41.

Broccoli Quiche

Jody Marsh, Parish Nurse

Broccoli, frozen, chopped, cooked, 1 1/2 cups Onion, medium (red), raw Garlic, fresh, 1 medium clove 2 eggs

1/4 c. almond milk, plain, unsweetened 2 light mozzarella string cheese sticks 1/2 c. potatoes, white or red, sliced and cooked 3 Tbsp. cottage cheese, 1%

Saute' onion, garlic, and potatoes in cooking spray. Add the broccoli in the onion, garlic, potatoes mix on the stove.

In a separate bowl, crack 2 eggs.

Pour in almond milk, a few tablespoons of cottage cheese and two part skim cheese sticks with eggs.

Mix it all together and cook it in the oven at 350 degrees for 30 minutes.
